President's Report:

- Association has been asked to help support putting printed signs in MCC staff's and MCC family's yards to show our support and appreciation for all families not just seniors. Estimated ask is \$900. Carmen Mitchell working with Ken Rasp to get the project going. It will take 4- 5 days to get signs once ordered. A design will be made and then approved with H & S as a supporter. The signs will then be delivered to front yards my Room Reps. Treats may also be delivered with the signs for the student depending on money left for the class in their allotment.
- Next year's class representatives were discussed and filled with volunteers.
- Board is in need of a Secretary, Vice President and President also.

- Home & School "Book Buy Back" to again take place with cleaning and sanitizing to take place before resale.
