#### **Approval of Minutes:**

#### **Principles Report:**

Student Surveys on class retreats were taken in grades 9 thru 12 w/ 7 thru 8th to still be done since their retreats have been rescheduled. Book Sale survey is still in the work so parents can better understand what the process is and what it does. Hoping to give parents more choices. There will be a Red Cross blood drive on 2/27. Students in classes 7 thru 12 will be attending the high school musical on 3/12. Our group was asked to help with the costs for the students to attend MCC Newsies performance at \$2 per student for 91 students at \$182. A student presentation to be held on vaping from Mercy Health Risks for grades 6-8 and 9-12 on April 19th.

#### **Treasure's Report:**

Krista's update let us know that the new MCC software for finance is coming along, but not yet far enough for us to see our true balance and "live" transactions. The MCC Book Sale brought in \$1,401.60 and the Opt-out collected amount to date is \$2,460. CSW t-shirts had a total of \$1,206.00 and the locker decals cost \$87.51. The amount of \$160 was donated to MCC Theatre for ad in the Spring Musical program. Krista is still waiting on receipts from the 8th grade outing from Genia Lehan. The balance that she shows at this time is \$10,193.32. The next fundraising opportunity will be March 15th a \$3 "Pay to Wear Green" for St. Patrick's Day.
