



MCEF Scholarship Funds

All Scholarships granted by the MCEF have the following minimum criteria:

- In addition to the criteria listed below, financial need is also a determining factor in the award process. Therefore a Smart Aid application is required to qualify for all of the scholarships listed.
- For each scholarship received, the Student must write a thank you letter acknowledging the donor or the award may be rescinded.
- If you would like your student to be considered for one of the following as part of their financial aid package, place a checkmark next to the applicable scholarship, add your student's name, attach documentation to substantiate your student's qualifications (letter from coach, parish representative or scout leader, transcript, etc.) and turn in to the business office by January 1st.

Note: Award of a named scholarship will not increase your overall award amount which is based on need as determined by Smart Aid.

Roger Chandonnet Memorial Scholarship Fund

Incoming freshmen who attended MCC Middle School

Preference given to the students who have attended MCS the longest

Student should be involved in at least one extra-curricular activity (sports, band, student council, etc.)

Preference will be given to students who have other siblings at GMCS.

Student must maintain a GPA of 2.5 or higher (on a scale of 4.0)

Ray Cioe Scholarship Fund and Theresa Cioe Scholarship Fund

Middle and High School students with preference to current families.

Student must maintain a GPA of 2.5 or higher (on a scale of 4.0)

Rev. Andrew Sikorski Memorial Scholarship Fund

Non-corporate (outside of Muskegon deanery), Catholic students

Floyd Kuehnl Scholarship Fund

Preference given to students who are active participants at St. Thomas Church in Muskegon

The recipient(s) shall have demonstrated a strong, personal, Catholic faith through his/her behavior in church, school, and the community

Appropriate input from the pastor at St. Thomas will be obtained

Student must maintain a GPA of 2.5 or higher (on a scale of 4.0)

Sacred Heart Scholarship Fund

The student must be a registered parishioner at Sacred Heart parish in Muskegon

Student must maintain a GPA of 2.5 or higher (on a scale of 4.0)

Peter F. and Mary Ann (Franczek) Koryzno Memorial Scholarship Fund

The recipient(s) shall have demonstrated a strong, personal, Catholic faith through his/her behavior in church, school, and the community

Preference given to students who have attended St. Michael Church in Muskegon

Additional preference given to students who have volunteered or been employed in an office setting

Scholarship cannot be given to the same student more than once

Maximum award amount is \$1000

Student must maintain a GPA of 2.5 or higher (on a scale of 4.0)

Demonstrated financial need

Demonstrated desire to attend Muskegon Catholic Central School

Given to student(s) deemed to have potential to respond favorably to the quality MCC education

Student must maintain a GPA of 2.5 or higher (on a scale of 4.0)

Mr. and Mrs. Elmer Kohley Scholarship Fund

Preference given to students who are active members of the Boy Scouts or Girl Scouts of America.

Student must maintain a GPA of 2.5 or higher (on a scale of 4.0)

William L. Tardani Catholic Education Scholarship Fund

Award based on family's financial need

St. Joseph's Credit Union Fund

Preference given to former members of St. Joseph's Parish in Muskegon

Kerry Ellis Memorial Scholarship Fund

Student shall be entering their senior year at MCC

Student shall have demonstrated strong interest and participation in the MCS Soccer Program in their freshman, sophomore and junior years at MCC

Student must maintain a GPA of 2.5 or higher (on a scale of 4.0)

Lynne Chandonnet Memorial Fine Arts Fund

Student shall have demonstrated a strong interest in the Fine Arts

Student must maintain a GPA of 2.5 or higher (on a scale of 4.0)

Knights of Columbus #706 Scholarship Fund

Preference given to children of members of the Knights of Columbus

Student must maintain a GPA of 2.5 or higher (on a scale of 4.0)

Jane Turner Green Scholarship Fund

The family and student have been in the MCS school system for many years

The student is performing academically at or near his/her capabilities

The family is experiencing unexpected financial difficulties due to causes beyond their control (medical, emergency, loss of employment, etc.)

Ted and Louise Price Scholarship Fund

Student(s) shall display a high level of interest in technology and mathematics

Student must maintain a GPA of 2.5 or higher (on a scale of 4.0)

Tom and Cathy Powers Minority Scholarship Fund

The student must be an ethnic minority

Student must maintain a GPA of 2.5 or higher (on a scale of 4.0)

Stan and Mary Tyler Scholarship Fund

At least one male and one female high school student

Students must maintain a grade point average of at least 3.0 (on a scale of 4.0) and remain eligible for participation in inter-scholastic sports

Students must be nominated by the Principal and/or Athletic Director as exemplifying the scholar-athlete

James and Leah Rae Morse Scholarship Fund

Student must maintain a grade point average of at least 2.5 (on a scale of 4.0) and an adequate discipline record

Helen Deyman Murphy Memorial Scholarship Fund

Student must maintain a grade point average of at least 2.5 (on a scale of 4.0) and an adequate discipline record

Father Robert Hart Scholarship Fund

Student must maintain grade point average of at least 2.5 (on a scale of 4.0) and an adequate discipline record

Demonstrated financial need

Frank Cereska Scholarship Fund

Practicing Christian Faith (preference to Catholic)

At least one extra-curricular activity (preference to football but not exclusive)

Transfer student in grades 8-9 or 10, but preference given to student in Middle School

Maintain 2.0 GPA and adequate disciplinary record
